- **Little JACK's** - we provide all elementary school grades K-2 with extra underwear and pants to give to children who soil their underwear/pants at school without access to a parent or change of clothes.
- **JA Hugs** - Ladies of JALC provide a tote bag full of necessities and comfort items for children entering the DCS system. Often children enter foster care with nothing and this bag provides hygiene items, pajamas, books, stuffed animals, etc.
- **Snack Sacks** - JALC provides a sack full of weekend long meals to children who otherwise will not be able to eat during the weekends. This program will continue another community program ('Backpack Club') for children moving from Ingram Sowell to E.O. Coffman Middle
